Refund Policy for Gnodi Node Software License(s)

General Policy

- Partial Use: If you have used part of the service but decide not to continue.

Refund Method

Approved refunds will be processed back to the original payment method. Please note that it may take up to 10 business days for the refund to appear in your account, depending on your payment provider.

Cancellation Policy for Cirrus

Termination

Cirrus may suspend or terminate the User's right to access or use Cirrus immediately and without notice if:

- Cirrus determines that the User's use of the services poses a security risk to Cirrus, its infrastructure, or any third party.
- The User engages in fraudulent activities or is in breach of any terms and conditions.
- The User initiates a chargeback or dispute related to any payment or purchase of Services.
- The User ceases to operate in the ordinary course, assigns assets for the benefit of creditors, or becomes subject to bankruptcy, reorganization, liquidation, or similar proceedings.

Cirrus reserves the right to cancel the User's account if the User is included in any trade embargoes or economic sanctions list (such as the United Nations Security Council Sanctions List), the list of specially designated nationals maintained by the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) of the U.S. Department of the Treasury, or the Denied Persons or Entity List of the U.S. Department of Commerce.
